
Available scholarship for European Young Chemists.

The **European Young Chemists**' Network (EYCN) together with the European Cooperation in Science and Technology (COST) Action "Biomimetic Radical CM1201 Chemistry" and the Horizon 2020 Initial Training Network (ITN) "ClickGene" are offering one (1) scholarship, for one (1) young chemist (age < 35 years old) that is currently studying or working in research in a COST member country to participate and present with an oral presentation the results from his/her research in the Young Investigators session of the joint

meeting that will take place **25th - 27th April 2016**, in **Grenoble** (France). The scholarship will cover for the selected candidate all the travel and accommodation expenses, in line with the COST regulations.
